During the month of May 2015 Forest Products export earnings experienced a reduction in its earnings when compared to the previous month of April 2015. **Logs** made an input of 46.54%; **Sawn Lumber** made a contribution of 34.63%; **Plywood** secured a fair share of the market with 10.34%; **Splitwood (Shingles)** earned market segment of 3.99%; **Roundwood and Fuelwood** absorbed a portion of the market with 3.61%; **Other Value Added Products** with a marginal input of 0.88%.

Log exports to date May 2015 represents a marginal 3.38% of the Annual Allowable Cut of timber in the forest sector. The month of May 2015 when compared to the month of April 2015 showed a decline in the export of forest products earnings by 32.34%. The comparative figure for May 2015 and May 2014 showed a positive increase in the total forest export earnings of 18.37% in 2015.

Fig 1 – FPDMC market report by monthly comparison (May 2015 and April 2015)

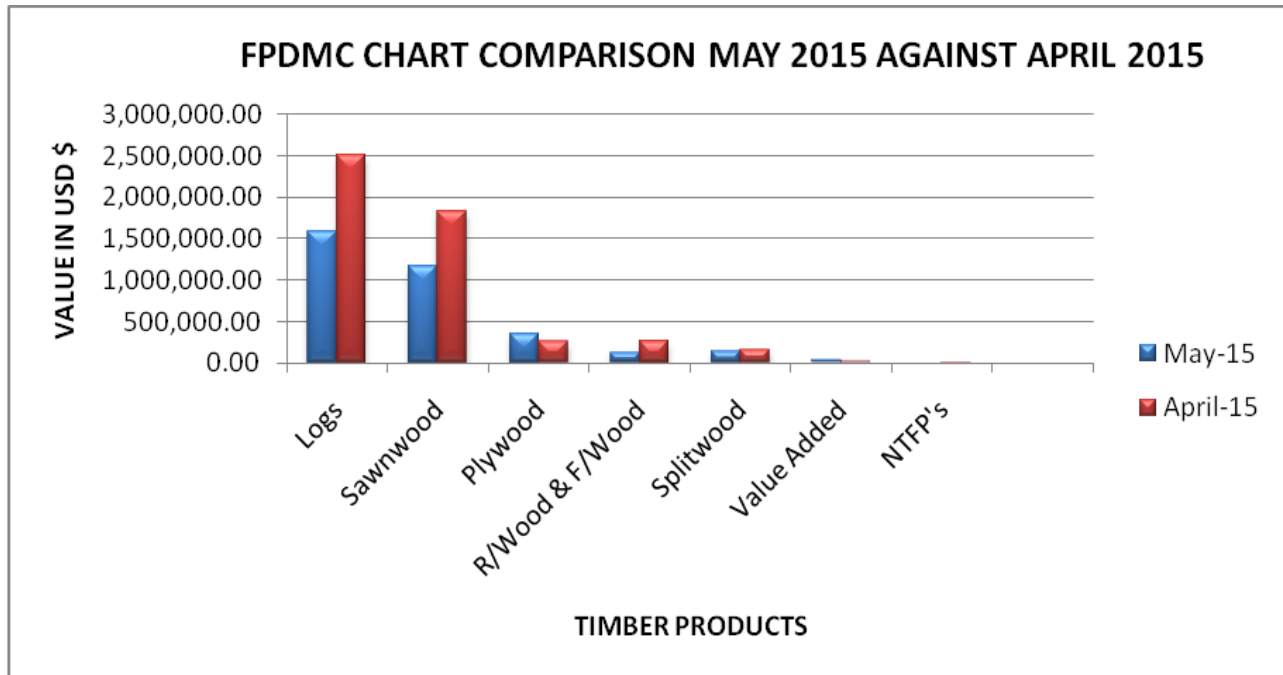
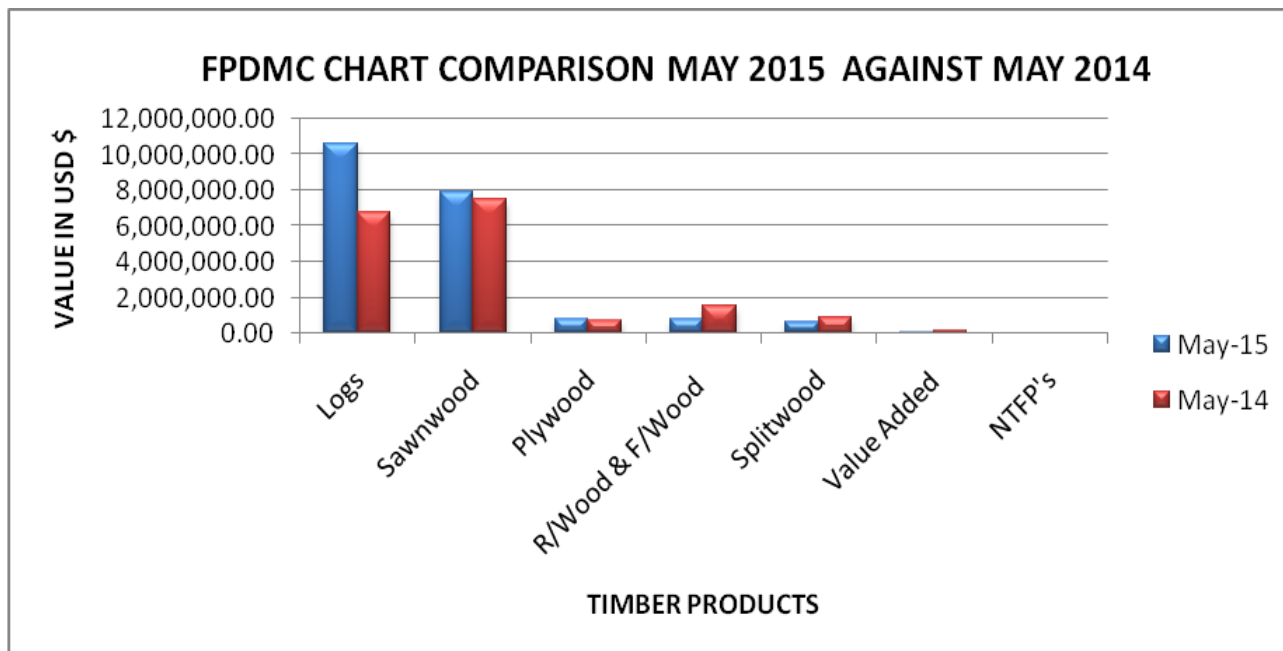


Fig 2 – FPDMC market report by annual comparison (May 2015 and May 2014)

During the month of May 15 timber species had minimum price activities on the export market. Darina (Und Lum – sel) had a top end price of USD 800 per cubic metre.

Greenheart (Und Lum – Prime) had a significant price increase from USD 950 to USD 1,820 per cubic metre.

Greenheart (Dr Lum) top end price made a significant leap from USD 1,454 to USD 2,580 per cubic metre.

Greenheart Piles (Prime) experienced a decrease in its top end price from USD 775 to USD 534 per cubic metre. Locust (Und – sel) top end price fell from USD 1,100 to USD 763 per cubic metre.

Undressed Purpleheart (sel) showed a decline in its top end price from USD 1,993 to USD 1,060 per cubic metre. Dressed Purpleheart price of USD 1,500 per cubic metre was stable for this month May 15 when compared to April 15.

Wallaba Shingles showed a dip in its top end price from USD 1,182 to USD 1,000 per cubic metre. Washiba (Dr) maintains stable prices of USD 2,750 per cubic metre. Guyana timber's continues to be exported to the Caribbean, Europe, Oceania Region and North America markets.

3.2. LOG EXPORT

Analysis of Quantity and Value

Logs main market was Asia during the month of May 15. China was the top market with a sizeable contribution of total volume 77.79% and total value 79.55%. India secured the remainder of the market with a contribution of total volume 22.21% and total value 20.45%. The month of May 15 when compared to the previous month of April 15 showed a reduction in the export of Logs by total volume 34.11% and total value 36.86%.

3.3. SAWNWOOD EXPORTS

DRESSED SAWN LUMBER EXPORT

Analysis of Quantity and Value

Dressed Sawn Lumber made a positive contribution towards the total export earnings for the month of May 15. The Caribbean secured the largest market share with a contribution of total volume 63.72% and total value 46.87%. North America absorbed a segment of the market with an input of total volume 22.10% and total value 37.52%. The Oceanic Region occupied the remainder portion of the Dressed Sawn Lumber by total volume 14.19% and total value 15.61%. The month of May 15 when compared to the previous month of April 15 revealed a drop in the export of Dressed Sawn by total volume 15.25% and total value 21.55%.

UNDRESSED SAWN LUMBER EXPORT

Analysis of Quantity and Value

Undressed Sawn Lumber made a notable contribution for the month of May 15. The Caribbean was the top earner for this product category and made a positive contribution of total volume 43.68% and total value 44.16%. Europe made noteworthy earning on the market with an input of total volume 16.05% and total value 20.73%. There were other markets that made a fair contribution which include Middle East, North America and Oceania Region. Middle East with total volume 0.51% and total value 1.45%, North America secured total volume 6.13% and total value 6.18% and Oceania Region occupied the market with an input of total volume 4.31% and total value 7.13%. The month of May 15 in comparison to the previous month of April 15 has recorded a reduction in the export of Undressed Sawn Lumber by total volume 46.05% and total value 52.49%.

3. 4 ROUNDWOOD and FUELWOOD EXPORTS

Piles: Analysis of Quantity and Value

Piles single market was North America and made a noteworthy contribution for the month of May 15. The month of May 15 in contrast to the previous period revealed a decline in the export of Piles by total volume 42.83% and total value 57.74%.

Posts: Analysis of Quantity and Value

Posts had no exports for the month of May 15.

Poles: Analysis of Quantity and Value

Poles primary market was the Caribbean, with a fair contribution towards the export earnings for the month of May 15. During the month of May 15 when compared to April 15 showed mixed earnings for the export of Piles, there was an increase in total volume by 10.33% and decrease in total value by 54.55%.

Charcoal: Analysis of Quantity and Value

Charcoal made a noteworthy contribution for the month of May 15. The primary market for Charcoal was the Caribbean. The top earner for Charcoal was Trinidad with a favourable input of total volume 90.73% and total value 86.29%. British Virgin Islands (BVI) secured the remainder of the market with a contribution of total volume 9.27% and total value 13.71%. The month of May 15 when compared to the previous month of April 15 revealed a positive increase in the export of Charcoals by total volume 72.67% and total value 81.56%.

3.5 SPLITWOOD (SHINGLES) EXPORT

Analysis of Quantity and Value

Shingles made a noteworthy contribution towards the export earnings for the month of May 15. The Caribbean was the top earner for the Shingles market with a favourable contribution of total volume 68.22% and total value 70.54%. The Oceania Region made a fair input of total volume 17.05% and total value 15.81%. The remainder of the market was absorbed by North America with a contribution of total volume 14.73% and total value 13.65%. The month of May 15 in comparison to April 15 revealed there was a marginal dip in the export of Shingles by total volume 0.03% but a larger drop in total value by 13.36%.

3.6 PLYWOOD EXPORT

Analysis of Quantity and Value

Plywood performance on the export market was noteworthy and made a positive contribution towards the total export earnings for the month of May 15. Central America secured the leading market for Plywood with a favourable input of total volume 75.07% and total value 72.75%. The Caribbean also made an encouraging contribution with total volume 20.19% and total value 22.25%. South America occupied the remainder segment of the Plywood market with an input of total volume 4.74% and total value 5.00%. The month of May 15 in contrast to the previous period of April 15 showed a positive increase in the export of Plywood by total volume 52.78% and total value 36.38%.
